Complex Sentences

Complex Sentences

 A complex sentence is made up of an independent clause (simple sentence) and one or more dependent clauses (phrases). An independent clause can stand on it's own

 it doesn't need anything else to help it
 become a sentence.

Example:

The team always runs 25 laps around the gym.

*This is a complete sentence. It makes sense on its own.

 A dependent clause can't stand on it's own. It depends on something else to make it a complete sentence.

Example:

Before basketball practice begins

*This is just a phrase. We need more information to make sense of it.

 Dependent clauses start with subordinating conjunctions. Here are the most common:

after because until although when unless as while since before if so
