

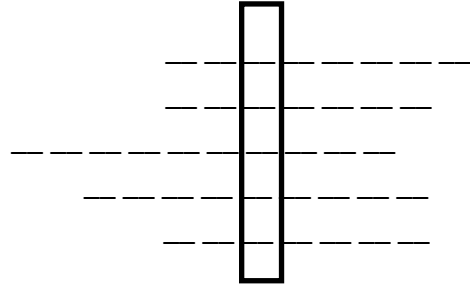

➤ The noun suffixes **ion**, **tion**, **sion**, **ition** and **ation** may cause changes in the spelling of the root word.

3. a) Add **ion** to decide, collide. (Drop e, change d to s.)

- b) Add **ion** to associate, delegate, illustrate, commune. (Drop e.)

- c) Add **ison** to compare. (Drop e.)

- d) Add **tion** to assume, consume, presume. (Change e to p.)

- e) Add **ion** to interrupt, digest, erupt, corrupt. (No change.)

- f) Add **ation** to assign, design. (Note changes in pronunciation.)

➤ The prefix **ad** means “to, toward.” This prefix can change depending on how it’s used.

ad becomes a before root words beginning with sc, sp, or st	ad becomes an before root words beginning with n
ad becomes ab before root words beginning with b	ad becomes ap before root words beginning with p
ad becomes ac before root words beginning with c, k, or qu	ad becomes ar before root words beginning with r
ad becomes af before root words beginning with f	ad becomes as before root words beginning with s
ad becomes ag before root words beginning with g	ad becomes at before root words beginning with t
ad becomes al before root words beginning with l
