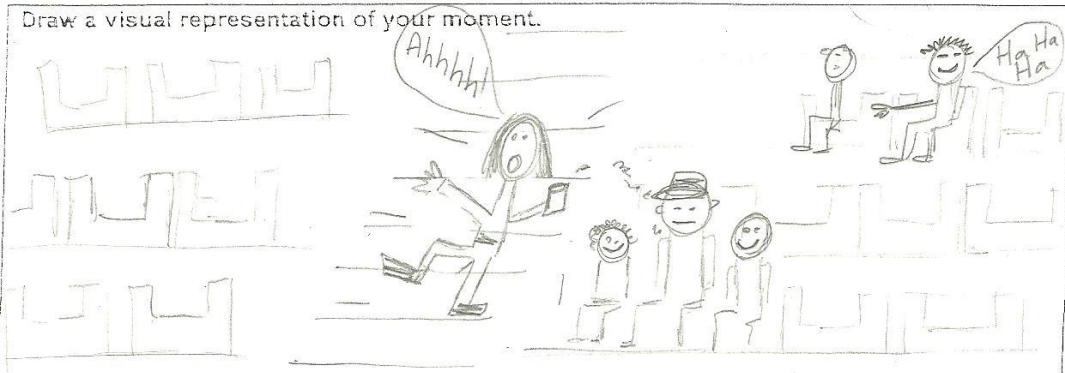


Memories that Inspire your Writing
